**ADVENT** "Fifteen days before Christmas, St. Francis asked a local man named John to help him realize his desire "to bring to life the memory of that babe born in Bethlehem, to see as much as possible with my own bodily eyes the discomfort of his infant needs, how he lay in a manger, and how, with an ox and an ass standing by, he was laid upon a bed of hay". At this, his faithful friend went immediately to prepare all that the Saint had asked. On 25 December, friars came to

Greccio from various parts, together with people from the farmsteads in the area, who brought flowers and torches to light up that holy night. When Francis arrived, he found a manger full of hay, an ox and a donkey. All those present experienced a new and indescribable joy in the presence of the Christmas scene. The priest then solemnly celebrated the Eucharist over the manger, showing the bond between the Incarnation of the Son of God and the Eucharist. At Greccio there were no statues; the nativity scene was enacted and experienced by all who were present." *Pope Francis, ADMIRABILE SIGNUM on the meaning and importance of the Nativity scene*.

THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM As we begin this new liturgical year of the Catholic Church with the Season of Advent, naturally our focus in on the infant Jesus and indeed our own family focus is also centred upon our children too! It is their beautiful innocence which rightly leads us to understanding the simple meaning of Christmas, Jesus' birthday, which is easily lost in the added stress experienced these December days! The Season of Christmas, which begins on Christmas Day, ends with the Feast of the Baptism of Our Lord. Jesus though was baptised by John the Baptist as a grown man. It is only through Our Saviour's death and resurrection that we enter a new and everlasting baptism, one which promises eternal life with God the a Father in Heaven. In the Rite of Baptism "the Christian community welcomes with great joy" the one presented for Baptism. The RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) guides and prepares those who as adult men and women seek to become members of the Catholic Church. But for most it is at the request of parents and guardians that the gift of Baptism is sought. Let us reflect on our Baptism identity and the whole meaning of the Sacrament of Baptism as we journey long this Advent in preparation for Jesus' birthday party! This weekend of Guadate Sunday (Joyful Sunday) let us truly be joyful in the Good News message we share as believers in Christ, Saviour of the World.
